


















POPULATIONS: BLACK AND LATIN X COMMUNITIES





The pandemic disproportionately impacts communities of color, compounding longstanding racial disparities. Although SUD are prevalent among all racial groups, the burden is disproportionate among Black, Latinx, and Indigenous people.

Psychological stress has long been seen as an important precipitant in the development of SUD.



















POPULATIONS: YOUNG ADULTS: GENERATION Z


Much like Millennials, members of Generation Z (Gen Z), run a higher risk of developing a substance abuse problem than previous age groups.




The events of these few years are emblematic of long-standing inequities and are rooted in a long history of systemic discrimination.


Despite all this—and in part because of all this—2022 has also emerged as a moment of opportunity, a possible inflection point for addressing inequity in a profound way.


