## **FREE NALOXONE IS AVAILABLE**

for you and your workplace! No prescription needed.

### **WHO MIGHT NEED ACCESS TO NALOXONE:**

- Anyone in a position to assist in the event of a potential opioid overdose
- Anyone who uses or knows someone who uses any type of opioid or other drugs, as they may contain hidden opioids

### **FOR INDIVIDUALS**

- Visit with a pharmacist using a smartphone or computer to have free naloxone mailed to you
  - Visit [NaloxoneIowa.org/Directory](http://NaloxoneIowa.org/Directory) or call 319-678-7825 to set up an appointment
- Visit a local pharmacy to receive free naloxone.  
(Call ahead to ensure availability)

## FOR WORKPLACES

- If your organization could be in a position to assist with a potential overdose, you may be eligible to receive free naloxone kits
- Visit the website to learn more and fill out a request form

\*Please note these sites may not distribute naloxone to individuals. Supplies are intended to reverse overdoses that may be encountered at these locations or during outreach.\*
